#### Position Summary:

Join a 6-8-person Rocky Mountain Youth Corps crew for the summer working on historic preservation projects in Salinas Pueblo Missions (SPM) National Monument, near Mountainair, New Mexico. Learn how to preserve historic structures through traditional techniques while also learning about the park's former inhabitants. Serve your community as part of a team while working with other RMYC members!

#### Job Description:

SPM crew members will perform manual labor alongside National Park Service preservationists throughout the park's historic ruins. Crew members will preserve structures, explore landscapes, and learn more about the cultural history of the monument and surrounding areas. Additionally, Corpsmembers will receive both personal and professional development training such as First Aid and CPR, financial management, public speaking skills, and much more.



#### Schedule:

Crews will work 28-35 hours per week (excluding lunch), Monday to Thursday and every other Friday. Normally the crew will meet in Mountainair or at a job site (Abo or Quarai). Occasionally we will provide transportation to Albuquerque for orientation, life skills trainings, and graduation with other RMYC crews. Typical schedule is 7:30 AM – 3:00 PM; daily schedule will vary depending on training schedule and travel needs.



#### Benefits:

Candidates will receive a living stipend of \$576 before taxes every two weeks, assuming full attendance.

#### Timeline:

June 5, 2017 – August 11, 2017

- Full 10-week commitment (no vacations)
- Some community service days on weekends

- Develop obtainable goals for your transition into further education or employment.

- Able to commit to entire term of service
- Able to work in a supervised environment
- Able to commute daily to crew meeting location: Mountainar, Abo, or Quarai

## Physical/Environmental/Emotional Requirements:

In performing the essential functions of this position, crew members will need to:

- Exert up to 50 pounds of force occasionally and/or up to 20 pounds of force frequently, and/or up to 10 pounds of force constantly to move objects.
- Frequently traverse uneven terrain, or sit in a vehicle/classroom.
- Read written materials, write, and communicate with others individually and in group settings.
- Work primarily in the outdoors and in all weather conditions.
