The U.S. Department of Commerce, Economic Development Administration (EDA) is considering a request for Federal assistance from Rocky Mountain Youth Corps to construct a Workforce Development Training Facility in the Town of Taos, Taos County, New Mexico. Pursuant to the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and the National Historic Preservation Act (NHPA), EDA is conducting an environmental assessment of the potential of the proposed project to affect the environment and/or historic properties.
